Autumn Term 2019

Taught by Miss Lucy Fletcher & Mrs Rachel Thomas, both registered teachers with the Royal Academy of Dance, the ballet classes at Notre Dame are offered to girls from Year 1 through to Year 6 with lessons also continuing into the Senior school. Classes from Pre-Primary to Grade 5 take place on a Thursday after school and on a Friday before & after the school day.

The Royal Academy of Dance syllabus has been created, specifically with fun and fitness in mind, whilst introducing a basic classical knowledge. The music is exciting and the innovative exercises allow the children to express their creativity and musicality.

Pupils enrolling for private ballet classes will study The Royal Academy of Dance syllabus, culminating in an examination. In order for children to benefit from these classes and achieve well in their examinations, a certain level of commitment is required, both from the children and parents.

Correct ballet uniform and well fitting ballet shoes as well as character skirt and shoes (from grade 1) are essential at every lesson. During the course of the year children may be required to undertake some practice in their own time. We will provide a minimum of 30 lessons per year.

Regular attendance at these lessons is essential in order to reach the required standard for entrance to RAD Examinations or Class Awards.

Pupils will only progress to the next grade when they reach RAD Examination or Award standard.

There is a fee payable for Examinations & Class Awards which will be charged to you when your daughter is entered for the exam.
